The re-publication shall be in one octavo volume, with an index and of a material equal in size and quality to the Session Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven. 3. The edition shall consist of one thousand copies and shall be distributed as follows: Two copies to each judicial district library; one copy to the clerks office of each county; one copy to each...
