This industrial process allows both texture and form to be created at the same time, and the finished clothes are not only beautifully form-enhancing, they also store easily, travel well, require no ironing, can be machine washed, and will dry within hours. In this abundantly illustrated book, the designer tells the story of this revolutionary line of clothing, from its inception, through material development, to its public reception. 575.
